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MS4 Permit Requirements

For construction sites:

- **Maintain inventory**
- **Review plans**
- **Conduct inspections**
- **Report non-filers**





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Uniform Requirements

All MS4s:

- **Require proof of CGP coverage**
- **Have a stormwater ordinance***
- **Conduct construction site inspections**

*** Except ADOT**

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Inspections

Different MS4s inspect:

- At different minimum frequencies
- Enforcing different local ordinances
- Using different types of inspectors





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Remember:

- Any construction site inspector may cite for stormwater violations
- ADEQ or EPA may also inspect at any time





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
